The state of Illinois will award the Alice Quinn Memorial Scholarship to an undergraduate and graduate Soror, annually when funds are available. To be considered, the applicant must meet the following requirements:

Requirements:

- Must submit a completed typewritten application to the Scholarship Chairperson or Designee on or before **Wednesday, September 2, 2015**;
- Undergraduate sorority member must be a **FULL** time student, currently pursuing an undergraduate degree at an accredited college or university in the state of Illinois;
- Graduate sorority member must be enrolled in a graduate program of an accredited college or university in the state of Illinois and must be enrolled in a minimum of two (2) courses per semester;
- Must submit three (3) letters of recommendations, one (1) from each of the following:
 - A financial Soror
 - A college professor, college dean and/or school counselor
 - A church official and/or employer
- Must submit an official transcript directly from the college or university to the Scholarship Committee Chairperson;
- Must have a B (3.0) average at the undergraduate level and/or on the graduate level;
- Must be financial on all levels of the sorority; local, state, regional and national (the applicant's financial status must be verified by the Chapter Basileus and the State Tamias-Grammateus);
- Must be an active member of a chapter within the state of Illinois for a minimum of one year prior to submitting the application, and
- Undergraduate Sorors must have attended a minimum of one (1) Illinois State Leadership Conference prior to the time the application is filed.
- Graduate Sorors must have attended a minimum of two (2) Illinois State Leadership Conferences prior to the time the application is filed.
- Graduate and Undergraduate Sorors must have attended at least one (1) Illinois State Leadership Academy Workshop prior to the time the application is filed.

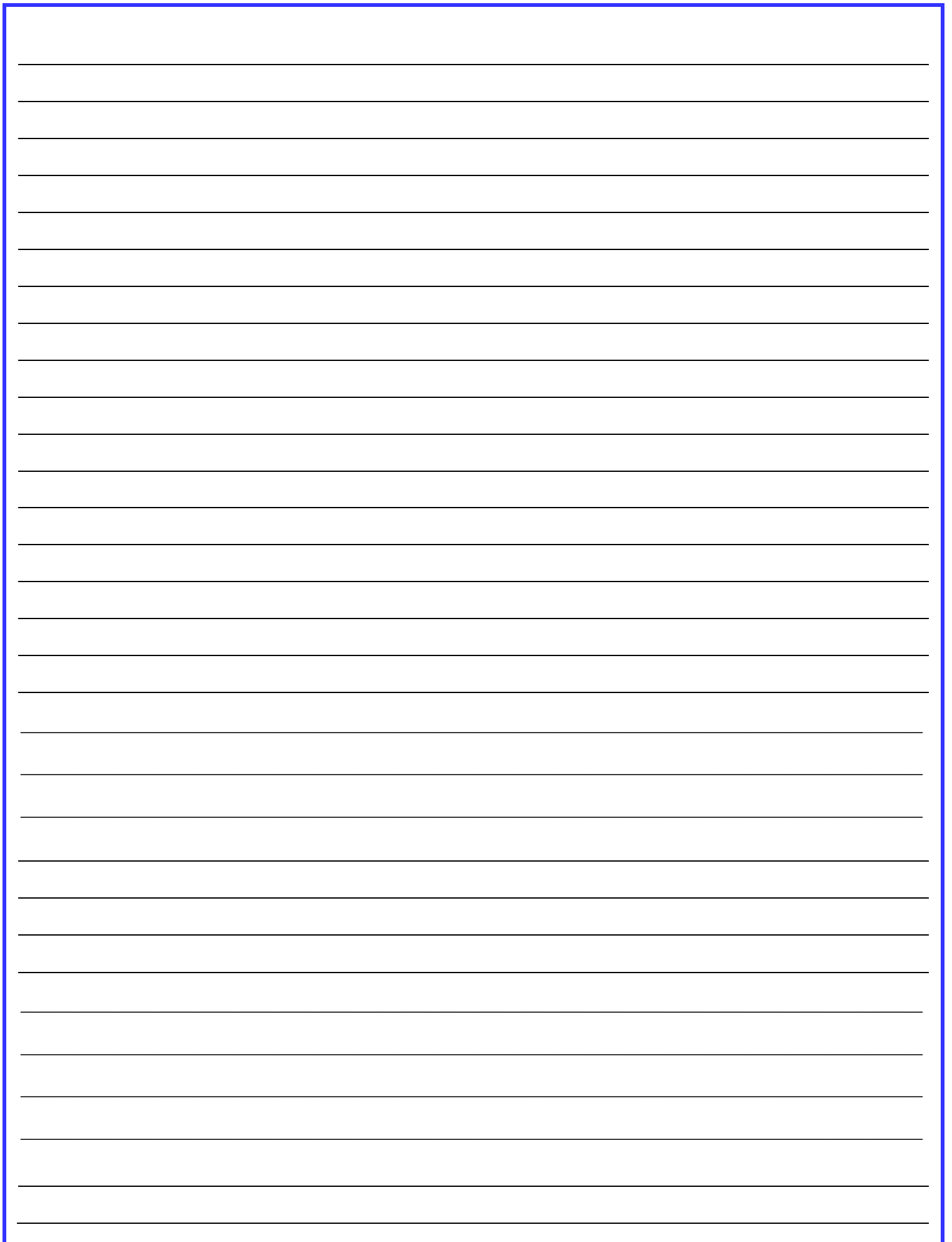
